

Fabric/Leather Care

1. Keep away from direct sunlight to avoid discolouration.
2. Wipe clean with a warm damp cloth. If there are slightly stubborn marks, use a small amount of soapy water. For white upholstery colour, avoid the seams if at all possible as this will darken them.
3. Avoid direct or close contact with radiators, fires or heated vents etc. these could cause discolouration and/or excessive drying of the cover.
4. Avoid salty water/excessive perspiration as this may corrode and discolour the cover.
5. If staining items come into contact with the cover (pen/lipstick/crayon/wine/tea/coffee/ etc.) wipe clean immediately to avoid excessive staining. If left this could cause irreparable damage without professional cleaning.

Spot Cleaning

Treat spills and stains as soon as they occur. Gently wipe or mop away any liquid spills from the surface of the fabric. Do not scrub with a stiff brush. Apply proprietary cleaning agents strictly according to instructions. Test on an inconspicuous area before use. Do not saturate the surface of the upholstery.

Frame and Base Care

1. Do not drag the bed across the floor when moving or repositioning, as this causes undue strain and can potentially damage the frame. Lift to move, preferably without the mattress.
2. Tighten the screws/bolts regularly (once every 3 months is preferable) to increase the longevity and to avoid damage to the joints.

Fire

1. Avoid contact with cigarettes and close proximity of fires – carelessness causes fires.
